Parent Teacher Organization:

The PTO is positively involved in weekly activities throughout the school. Trying to ensure our teachers and staff feel appreciated as well as ensuring to offer a variety of activities for the school, this organization is looking for you to join the team. Catholic Youth Organization:

The St. Patrick CYO Program is a Parish organization. The Divine Grace Men's Club provides full funding of our programs.
