We know that balancing schedules can be challenging. To help, St. Patrick School offers a state licensed Latchkey program for the students who attend Preschool through 8th grade.

MORNING: 6:30AM – 7:25AM

In the School Gym.

AFTERNOON: 3:00PM -6:00PM

What

The Latchkey program provides a structured experience for students that consists of snack time and homework, along with social activities and play time. Students enjoy fun outdoor activities and special celebrations throughout the year.

Cost

The program is designed as a 'Pay-per-use' and is tax deductible. It is \$4.50/hour for first child and \$4.20 for each additional child. Families are billed weekly.

Benefit

You'll have a peace of mind knowing your children are safe and well cared for in a nurturing, caring, and fun environment. Children will have the opportunity to make friends and build relationships with individuals they would not otherwise encounter during the school day.

Afternoon Latchkey Pick-Up Routine

1. Entrance doors located by main office of new school. When you arrive to pick up your child, please ring white doorbell located to the right of the door. The doorbell will alert latchkey staff and they will allow parent in.
2. Latchkey staff will meet parents, or designated adult, outside of classroom. Staff may ask for identification to ensure safety is adult is a non-parent or unfamiliar.
3. Sign-out your child on the form located in the latchkey classroom.

Please communicate with your child or their teacher if they will be going to latchkey after school.
